



Yummy Cupcake Pin

Supplies Needed:

- 9" x 12" craft cut Kunin Corduroy: *Candy Pink*
- 9" x 12" craft cut Kunin Coordinates: *Lagoon with White Dots*
- Red Pom Poms
- Beads
- Embroidery Floss
- Embroidery Needle
- Scissors
- Pin Brooch Clasp

How To Make It

1. Cut 2 full cupcakes from the Candy Pink Corduroy felt and just the icing part from the Lagoon with White Dots Coordinates felt.
2. Trim the bottom of the icing part to give it curves.
3. Using embroidery floss and needles, sew beads on the icing part to make it look like sprinkles.
4. Glue the two Candy Pink pieces together to make it sturdy and then glue the icing part on the top.
5. Glue a red pom pom to the top to look like a cherry.
6. With the hot glue gun and hot glue, attach the pin brooch clasp to the back.
