

Felt in the Classroom: Spring Flowers

Supplies

- 1 – 9"x12" Craft Cut of Kunin Classic in Yellow
 - 1 – 9"x12" Craft Cut of Kunin Classic in Ocean Blue
 - 1 – 9"x12" Craft Cut of Kunin Classic in Pirate Green
 - 1 – 9"x12" Craft Cut of Kunin Classic in Candy Pink
 - 1 – 9"x12" Craft Cut of Kunin Classic in Neon Green
 - 1 – 9"x12" Craft Cut of Kunin Corduroy in Candy Pink
 - 1 – 9"x12" Craft Cut of Kunin Corduroy in Orange
 - 1 – 9"x12" Craft Cut of Kunin Coordinates in White Dot on Candy Pink
 - 1 – 9"x12" Craft Cut of Kunin Coordinates in White Dot on Baby Pink
 - 1 – 9"x12" Craft Cut of Kunin Coordinates in White Dot on Lagoon
 - 1 – Pair of Scissors
 - 1 – Fabric Glue or a Hot Glue Gun (with glue sticks)
 - 1 – Recyclable Container (Glass or Plastic)
 - 1 – Ellison Superstar Machine
 - 1 – Sizzix Bigz Die Set - Pet Shop Flashcards (4 Die Set) Item #A11056
 - 1 – Sizzix Bigz Die - Circle 3" Fraction 1/8 Item #A10208
 - 1 – Sizzix Bigz Die Set - Badges (4 Die Set) Item #A11114
- Green Pipe Cleaners



Directions

1. Using a variety of colors of Craft Cuts of Kunin Classic, Kunin Corduroy and Kunin Coordinates, creating these DIY felt flowers is easy! You can also use your Ellison Superstar Machine with a number of Ellison dies to add embellishments to your felt flowers, too! I used Laura Kelly's Sizzix Bigz Die Set - Pet Shop Flashcards for the vase of my flower and the Sizzix Bigz Die Set - Badges to add embellishments to each vase. (Figure A)
2. After preparing your design and using a variety of colors of felt, prepare each vase for assembly. Adhere each piece of felt onto your vase using fabric glue or a hot glue gun. (Figure B)
3. I used my Ellison Superstar Machine and the Sizzix Bigz Die - Circle 3" Fraction 1/8 to die cut triangles of 9"x12" Craft Cuts of Kunin Corduroy in Candy Pink and Orange and 9"x12" Craft Cuts of Kunin Classic in Ocean Blue. Using hot glue or felt glue, adhere each triangle onto a piece of cardstock. Add a small circle to the center of your flower using 9"x12" Craft Cuts of Kunin Classic in Yellow. (Figure C)
4. Flip your flower over and adhere a green pipe cleaner to the back of your flower using fabric glue or hot glue. (Figure D)
5. Adhere the other end of your pipe cleaner to the backside of your vase. Cut the remaining pipe cleaner off from the base of the vase. (Figure E)
6. Using a 9"x12" Craft Cut of Kunin Classic in Pirate Green, cut out a leaf and adhere to the stem of your flower. Adhere your DIY felt flower to the recycled container of your choice. (Figure F)
